


“An Old Bible Rediscovered in Cairo and the Future of Egyptian-Jewish Heritage”

While only few Egyptian-Jews still live in Cairo, an unprecedented shift is developing in terms of the heritage of the Jewish community, its assets, and in general it's public visibility.
